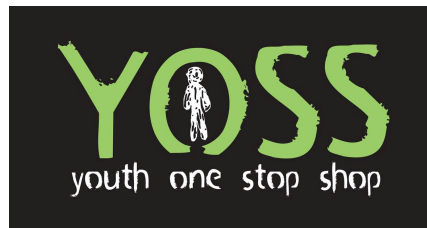


YOUTH DIRECTORY
